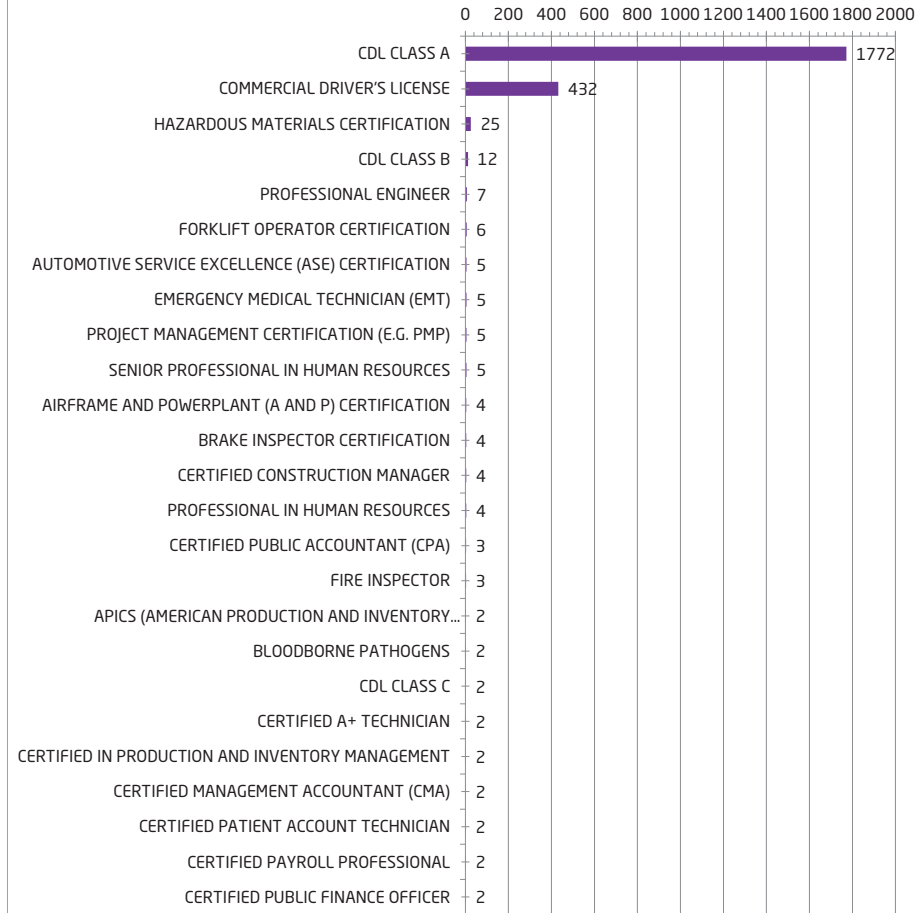

Certifications in Greatest Demand 5,212 Job Postings from 412 Businesses (FY17)

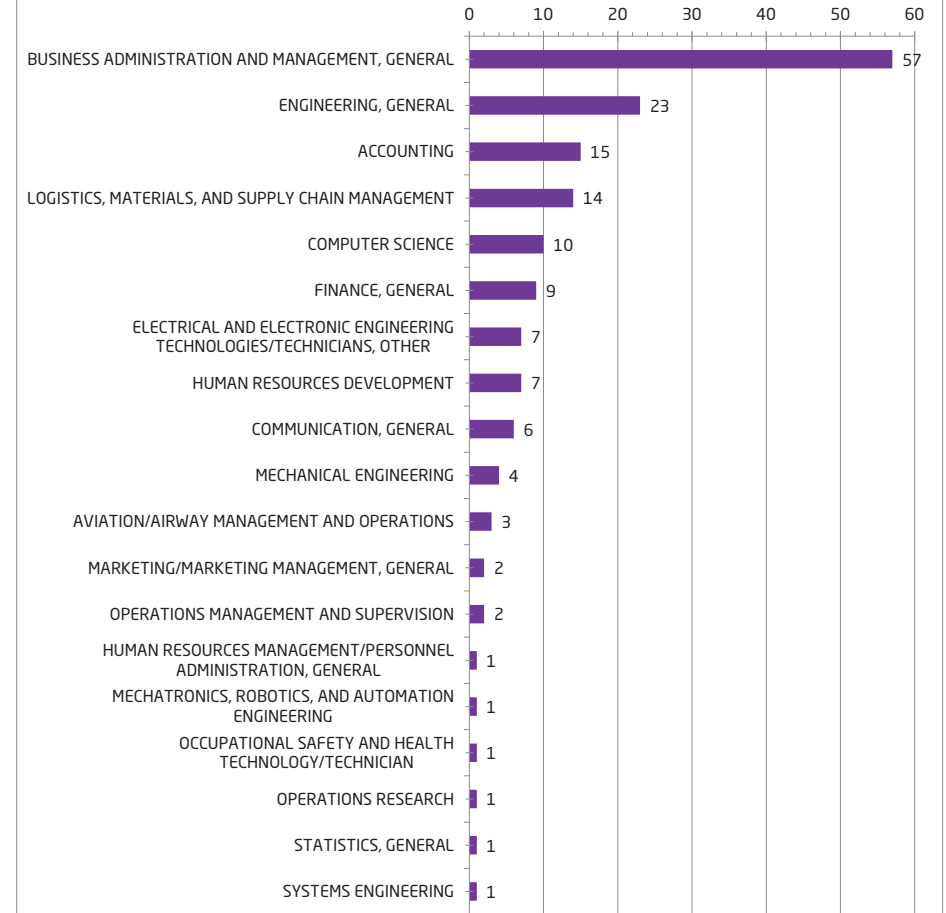

Post-Secondary Programs of Study in Greatest Demand 5,212 Job Postings from 412 Businesses (FY17)



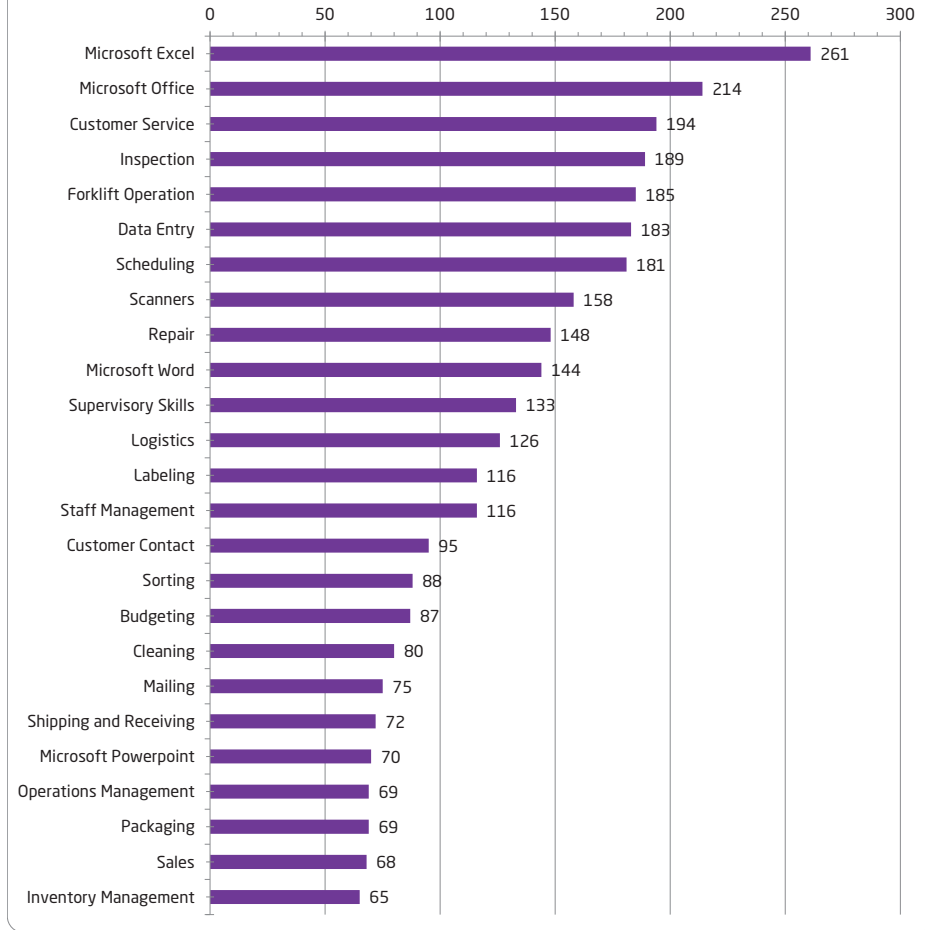

5,212 Job Postings from 412 Businesses (FY17)

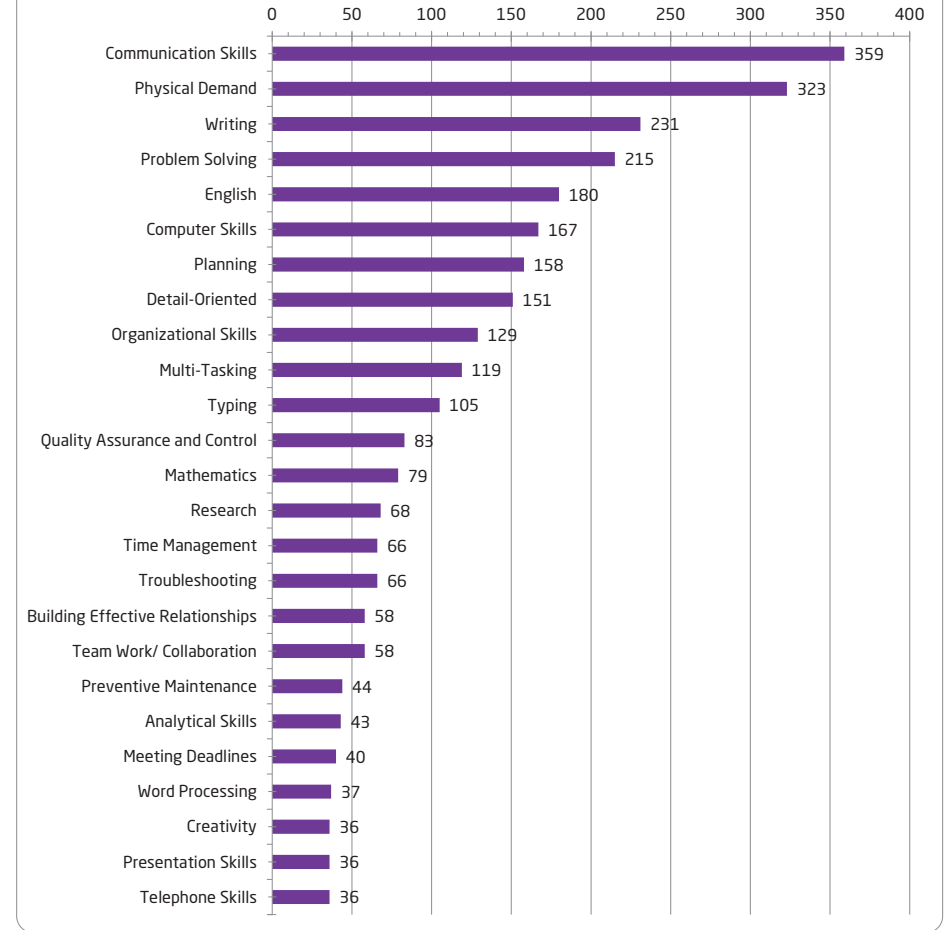
